Dear Ms. Park,

Ref. South Bucks Core Strategy/LDF
Representations concerning other Development Sites
Land adjoining Limewood Gate, Poyle Lane, Burnham.

Thank you again for your email of today, informing me that the Inspector has already visited the site.

As you know, I have been out of action for some time , due to recent serious health problems. I was hoping for a full inspection of the site and would have personally arranged for the entrance gates, at both access points, to be unlocked and opened , so that the Inspector could walk through the site and observe all the existing buildings , paths and driveways which exist.

At this time of year, the grounds are left practically unattended , apart from when emergencies occur. From early March, up until mid-October, the grounds are cared for and maintained by Contractors, every fortnight. The grass alongside the tree lined avenue is cut every two weeks and the driveways are treated accordingly at the same time. (see enclosed photographs). The outside verges on each side of the access points of the site are also cut and maintained fortnightly.

However, in the absence of the requested Inspector's detailed site visit, I have prepared and enclose a document detailing "The History of the Site". (Formally part of the Ashcroft Tower Estate), and a photograph, given to me by one of our neighbours, taken on 20th April, 1948.

I feel that it is absolutely essential, in fairness to all parties, that the Inspector has the fullest knowledge of the site , to enable her to understand, and support, our case for its future use, which will certainly secure and preserve permanently this remaining piece of previously developed land.
