Thank you for your letter received by the District Planning Authority on the 6<sup>th</sup> February 2006 concerning the above.

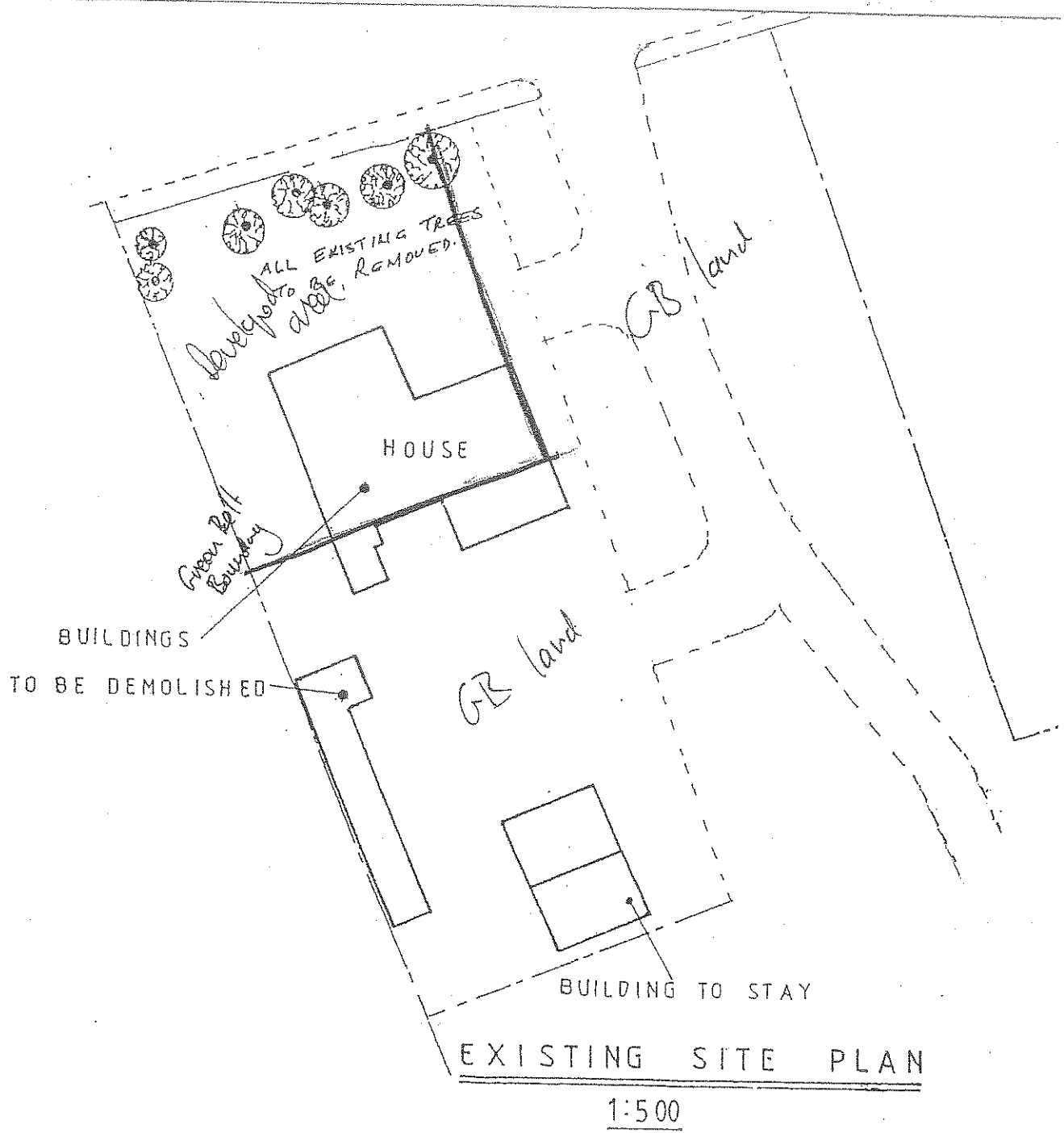

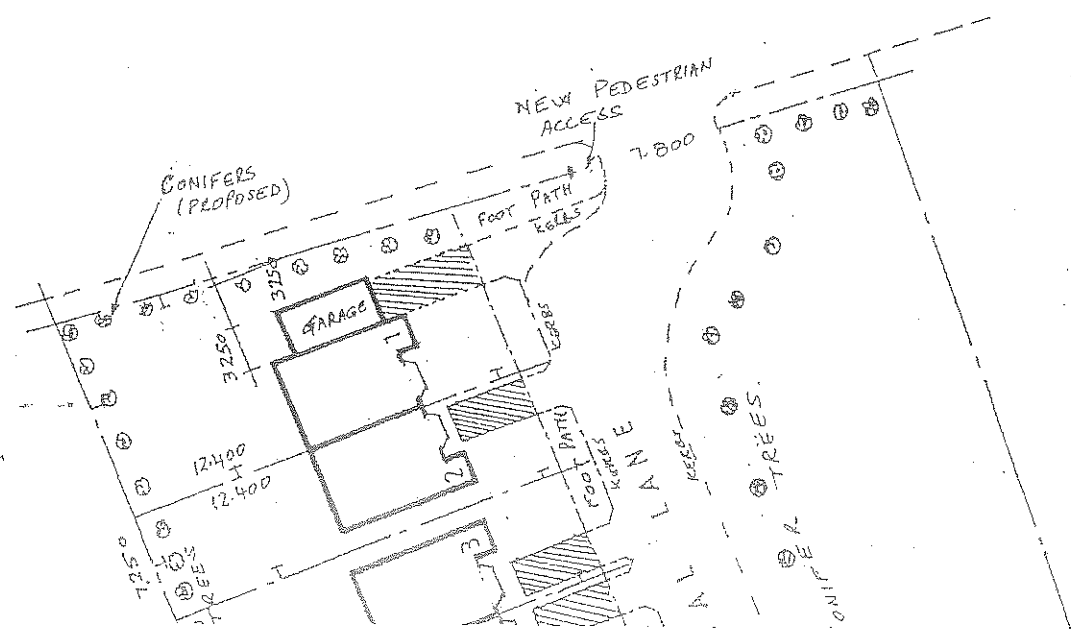
