## The purpose of this addendum

Please read this document in conjunction with the Review of Established Residential Areas of Special Character undertaken by Chris Blandford Associates (February 2011).

This addendum has been prepared to clarify minor aspects of the February 2011 review.

## Details

In paragraph 4.2.7 on Pages 12 and 13 of the February 2011 review the description for areas 3 and 4 should refer to Clarendon Road, not Greenlands Lane.

In paragraph 4.2.3 on page 9 of the February 2011 review the following information about the Fullers Hill Residential Area should be added;

Fullers Hill Residential Area is considered to have moderate sensitivity of townscape character overall as a result of the strong historic integrity, pattern of buildings which create a continuous façade, and the historic buildings/mature vegetation which contribute to a distinctive and recognisable sense of place. Housing along Fullers Hill and at the junction between Fullers Hill and Wey Lane, however, is considered to have high sensitivity of townscape character as result of the strong historic integrity and distinctive architectural details. This area of housing has therefore been included within a Proposed Area of Little Change.
