The purpose of this addendum

This addendum has been prepared by Chiltern District Council to clarify an aspect of the Assessment which was highlighted in one of the responses to the public participation on the Delivery Development Plan Document (April – June 2013).

Details

In paragraph 9.4.17 of the Assessment the Mill House should be referred to as being of early 19th century date, not early 20th century. It is not post 1970s development or 19th century terraces.

Therefore the first sentence of this paragraph should read as follows, deleted text is shown in brackets;

Although not listed this area contains a fine, early 19th (~~20th~~) century house built in the Tudor Revival style complete with handmade tiles, low eaves, elaborate chimneys and leaded glass.
